FAST FACTS FROM THE 2015-16 ANGOLA IIMS

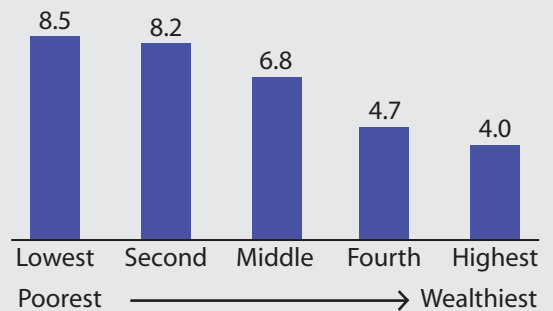
The 2015-16 Angola Multiple Indicator and Health Survey (IIMS) is designed to provide data for monitoring the population and health situation in Angola. The 2015-16 IIMS is the 1st Demographic and Health Survey and the 4th Multiple Indicator Cluster Survey conducted in Angola.

FERTILITY

Women in Angola have an average of **6.2 children**. Fertility decreases as household wealth increases.

Percent of married women age 15-49 using family planning

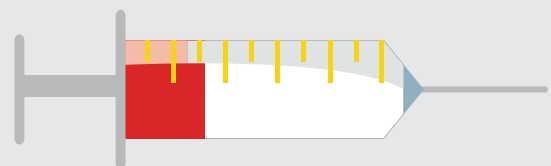


13% of married women in Angola use a modern method of family planning. Injectables are the most popular method.
