

# 2012 Kyrgyz Republic Demographic and Health Survey (KgDHS)

The 2012 Kyrgyz Republic Demographic and Health Survey (KgDHS) provides up-to-date information on the population and health situation in the Kyrgyz Republic. The 2012 KgDHS is the second national demographic and health survey conducted in the country; the first was in 1997. UNICEF conducted a MICS survey in 2006.

The survey is based on a nationally representative sample. It provides estimates for rural and urban areas of the country and for each of the 9 regions.

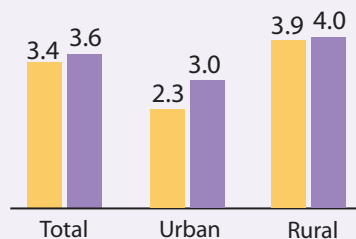

## Fertility Trends by Residence

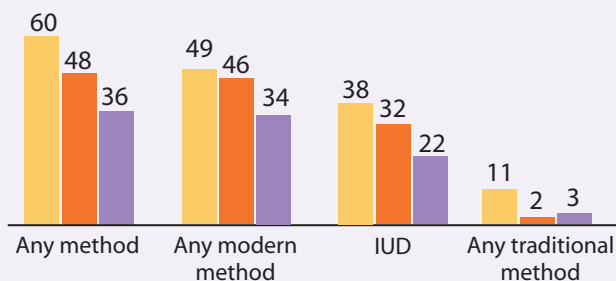
■ 1997 KgDHS ■ 2012 KgDHS

## Trends in Family Planning Use

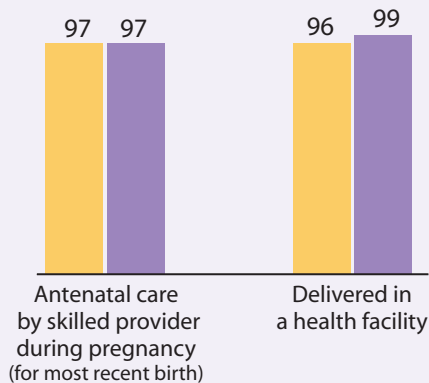
■ 1997 KgDHS ■ 2006 MICS ■ 2012 KgDHS

## Vaccination Coverage by Wealth Quintile

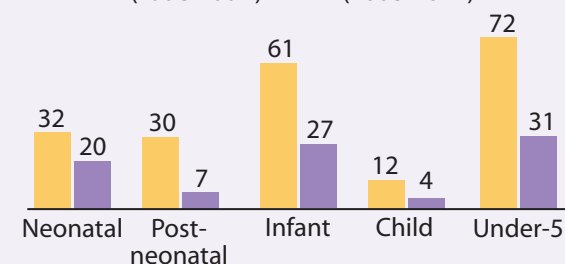
Percent of children 18–29 months who have received all basic vaccinations

Deaths per 1,000 live births

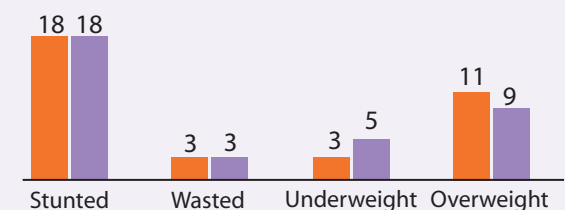
■ 1997 KgDHS (1993–1997) ■ 2012 KgDHS (2008–2012)



## Trends in Children's Nutritional Status

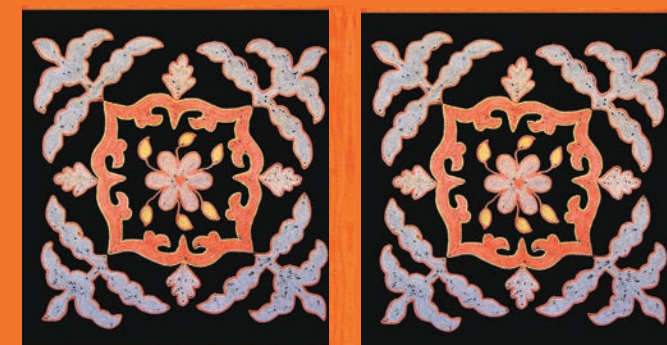
Percentage of children under age 5, according to 2006 WHO Child Growth Standards

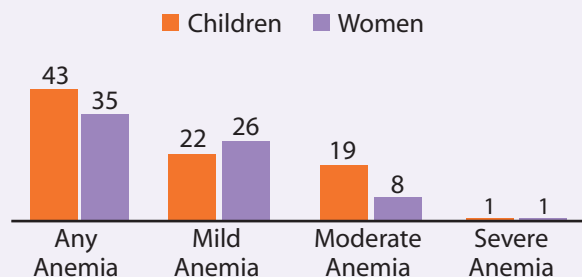

Percent of women and men 15-49

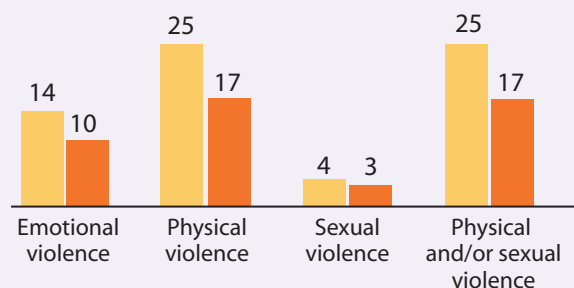
Percent who know that the risk of HIV can be reduced by:
