## FAST FACTS FROM THE 2015-16 MALAWI MDHS

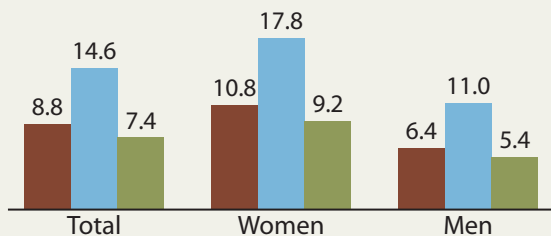
The 2015-16 Malawi DHS (MDHS) is designed to provide data for monitoring the population and health situation in Malawi. The 2015-16 MDHS is the 5th Demographic and Health Survey conducted in Malawi since 1992.

### ● HIV PREVALENCE ●

#### HIV Prevalence by Residence

Percent of women and men age 15-49 who are HIV positive

■ Malawi ■ Urban ■ Rural



**8.8%** of Malawian adults age 15-49 in are **HIV positive**. HIV prevalence is higher among women than among men.

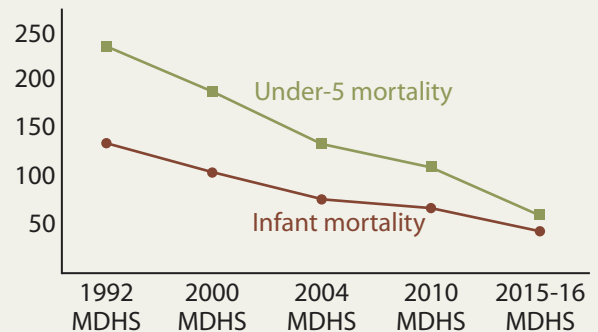
### ● CHILDHOOD MORTALITY ●



Childhood mortality has sharply declined since 1992. **1 in 16** Malawian children dies before their 5th birthday.

#### Trends in Childhood Mortality

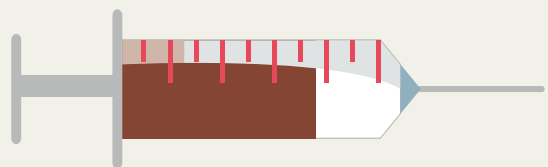
Deaths per 1,000 live births for the five-year period before the survey



### ● MATERNAL AND CHILD HEALTH ●



**Half** of women age 15-49 attended **4+** antenatal care visits.



**76%** of children age 12-23 months have received **all** basic vaccinations.
