WOMEN'S EMPOWERMENT

Decision Making

86% of married women participate in decisions about their own health care, an increase from **79%** in 2014.

78% participate in decisions about major household purchases, an increase from **73%** in 2014.

82% participate in decisions about visiting their own family or relatives, an increase from **74%** in 2014.

Marriage Registration

19% of married women are in unions that are registered with a civil authority.

Ownership and use of bank accounts and mobile phones

Percentage of women age 15-49 who have used a bank account or a mobile phone for financial transactions in the last 12 months, by wealth quintile

Financial Inclusion

Nearly 8 in 10 women age 15-49 used a bank account or mobile phone for financial transactions in the last 12 months.

Women's use of bank accounts or mobile phones for financial transactions increases as wealth quintile increases, from 56% in the lowest to 92% in the highest.



Ownership of Assets

33% of women own a house alone or jointly.

25% of women own agricultural land alone or jointly.

7% of women own nonagricultural land alone or jointly.

Gender-Based Violence

22% of women age 15-49 who ever had a husband or intimate partner experienced psychological/emotional violence in the last 12 months by any husband or intimate partner. 6% experienced physical violence in the last 12 months by any husband or



intimate partner.
