
HIV Prevalence by Province

2024 Zambia Demographic and Health Survey


The 2024 ZDHS provides data on basic demographic and health indicators that enable the monitoring of the health status of the population of Zambia. The 2024 ZDHS is the seventh demographic and health survey in Zambia. The survey is based on a nationally representative sample and provides estimates for the national level, urban-rural areas and for each of the 10 provinces.


Percent of married women age 15-49 using:






Total Fertility Rate Trends by Residence

Average number of births per woman for the 3-year period before the survey




