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The Demographic and Health Surveys (DHS) is a 13-year project to assist government and private agencies in developing countries to conduct national sample surveys on population and maternal and child health. Funded primarily by the United States Agency for International Development (USAID), DHS is administered by Macro International Inc. in Calverton, Maryland.

The main objectives of the DHS program are (1) to promote widespread dissemination and utilization of DHS data among policymakers, (2) to expand the international population and health database, (3) to advance survey methodology, and (4) to develop in participating countries the skills and resources necessary to conduct high-quality demographic and health surveys.

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1 How to Use This Report

This report documents the contents of questionnaires used in 27 surveys conducted under Phase I of the Demographic and Health Surveys Program. The report consists of a collection of tables containing information on the inclusion and wording of questions and their deviations from the Model "A" and Model "B" (or core) questionnaires. The tables are intended to be useful to those carrying out analyses, especially comparative analyses, of DHS data files. A description of each set of tables is provided below.

It is important for users of this report to be aware, however, that while the tables shown here provide information on the contents of the questionnaires used in the surveys, there is no substitute for examining the questionnaires themselves. Country-specific questionnaires can be found in the final report of each survey.

QUESTIONNAIRE SECTIONS

Table 1 presents a comparison between the sections used in the core questionnaire and the sections used in the individual country questionnaire. This information is provided so that data users will know where to look in country questionnaires for questions on a particular broad topic. In addition, the table includes a list of country-specific sections.

HOUSEHOLD SCHEDULE

Table 2 shows the information collected in the household schedule in each individual country survey. Question titles are listed in capital letters if the information is obtained as specified in the core questionnaire. Country-specific questions are marked with an asterisk.

INDIVIDUAL WOMAN'S QUESTIONNAIRE - QUESTION NUMBERS

In Table 3, the first column summarizes the question in a "Question Title." The next two columns show the number of the question in the Model "A" or

Model "B" questionnaire. The number of the corresponding question in each country survey questionnaire is shown in the subsequent columns. If a question was not included in a country questionnaire, it is recorded as "---." This table allows the analyst to determine quickly whether a particular question was included in the questionnaire for a specific country and where to look for it in the questionnaire. Details of the content of specific questions can be found in the next set of tables.

COMPARISON OF COUNTRY QUESTIONS WITH MODEL QUESTIONS

A detailed assessment of the comparability of questions included in each individual country questionnaire with the questions in the model questionnaires is provided in Tables 4.1-4.8. Each table covers one section of the questionnaire, except for Section 3, which requires two tables. As in the previous table, these tables list the questions according to title and question number in the Model A and Model B questionnaires.

Three columns of information appear for each country. The question number corresponding to the core question is indicated under the column headed "No.," If a question in the Model Questionnaire was not included in the country questionnaire, it is listed as "---."

In the next column under "Base" appears either an "A" or a "B" signifying which core questionnaire's base the question is patterned after. "Base" indicates the population of respondents to whom (or about whom) the question was asked (e.g., All respondents, Pregnant respondents, respondents who are Current Users, etc.) as determined by the skips and filters. If the base of the country question differs from the core question base, the base will be noted in this column by a single letter or a combination of letters. The key to these letters is found at the bottom of the table.

The last column under each country contains information about the wording of the question in comparison to the core question's wording. The predominant entry of "S" means the wording is the

Same in the country questionnaire as in the Model Questionnaire. A "C" will appear in this column to signify that the wording of the question is Comparable to the core question. Other differences that actually change the information obtained are designated by an "F," "R," or by a number. An "F" indicates the question addresses the same issue as the core question, but is structured differently. An "R" signifies the question is the same as the core, but different or country-specific response codes are available. A number listed under this heading will be explained in a footnote.

COUNTRY SPECIFIC QUESTIONS

In Table 5, country specific questions - questions not included in the core questionnaires - are listed. Many country questionnaires contain groups of questions on particular subjects (ORT use and preparation, AIDS, pill packaging, etc.). These groupings have been listed under general headings in this table and placed in alphabetical order. The purpose of this table is the identification of areas of particular interest in various countries. It is not as in-depth as the tables comparing the country questionnaires to the core questionnaires in that it does not specify population bases or wording. Only a brief description of the question is found under the "Question Title" heading. This table will, however, provide the analyst with a means of identifying which datasets contain information on specific topics not included in the core questionnaires.

CONTRACEPTIVE METHODS

Knowledge and use of contraceptive methods is assessed in the DHS Model Questionnaires. Questions are asked about a standard set of contraceptive methods. In some countries, however, the standard set was expanded to reflect the use of other methods. Table 6 documents the list of methods about which questions were asked in each country questionnaire.

VACCINATIONS

In Section 4 of the Model Questionnaires for DHS-I, information is collected on whether or not children

have been vaccinated against six childhood diseases: tuberculosis, diphtheria, pertussis, tetanus, polio, and measles. These vaccinations are generally given in a series of injections: BCG (tuberculosis), DPT 1, DPT 2, DPT 3 (diphtheria, pertussis, tetanus), Polio 1, Polio 2, Polio 3, and measles. In some countries, the recommended series of injections is modified. The questionnaires for these countries were altered accordingly and these modifications are documented in Table 7.

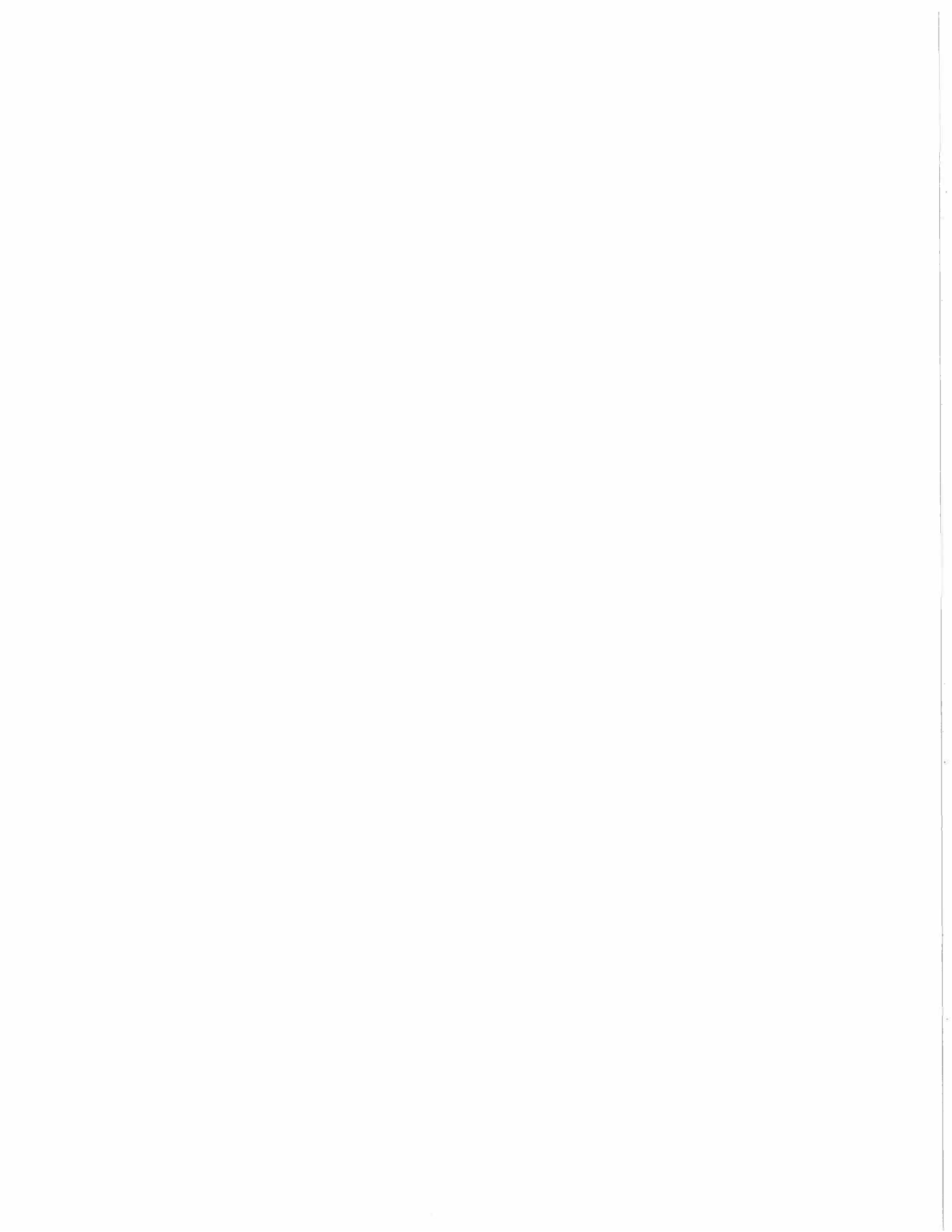

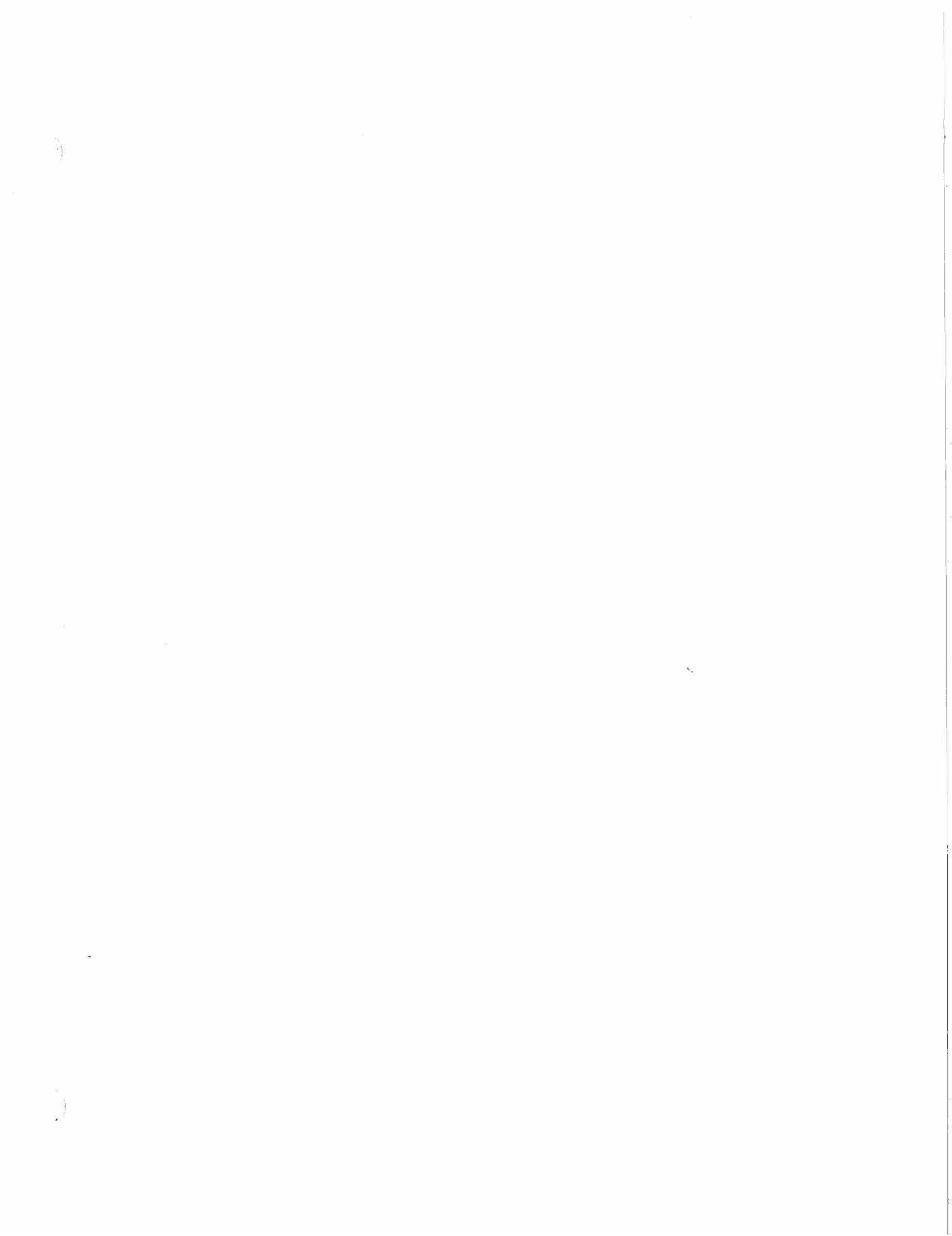

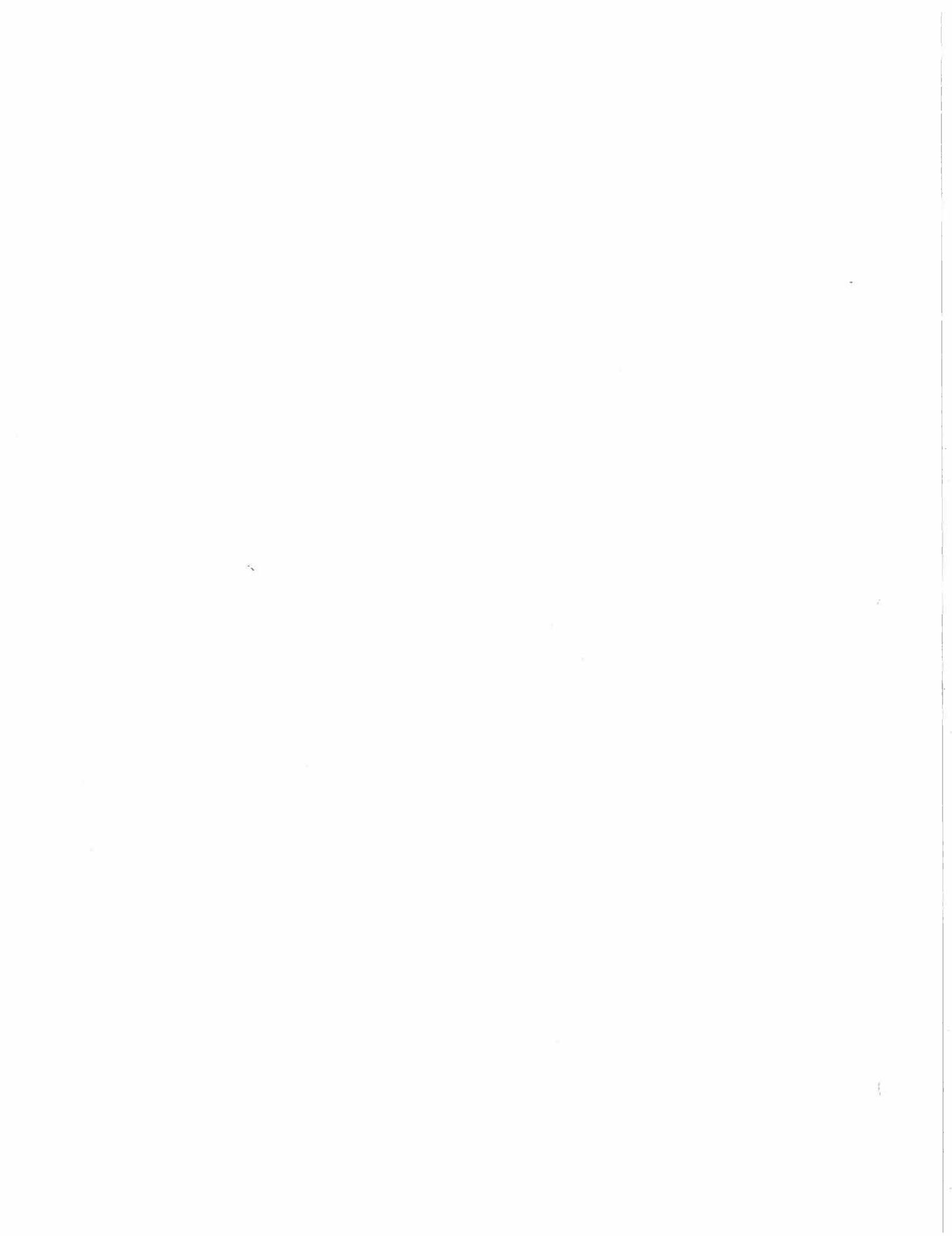

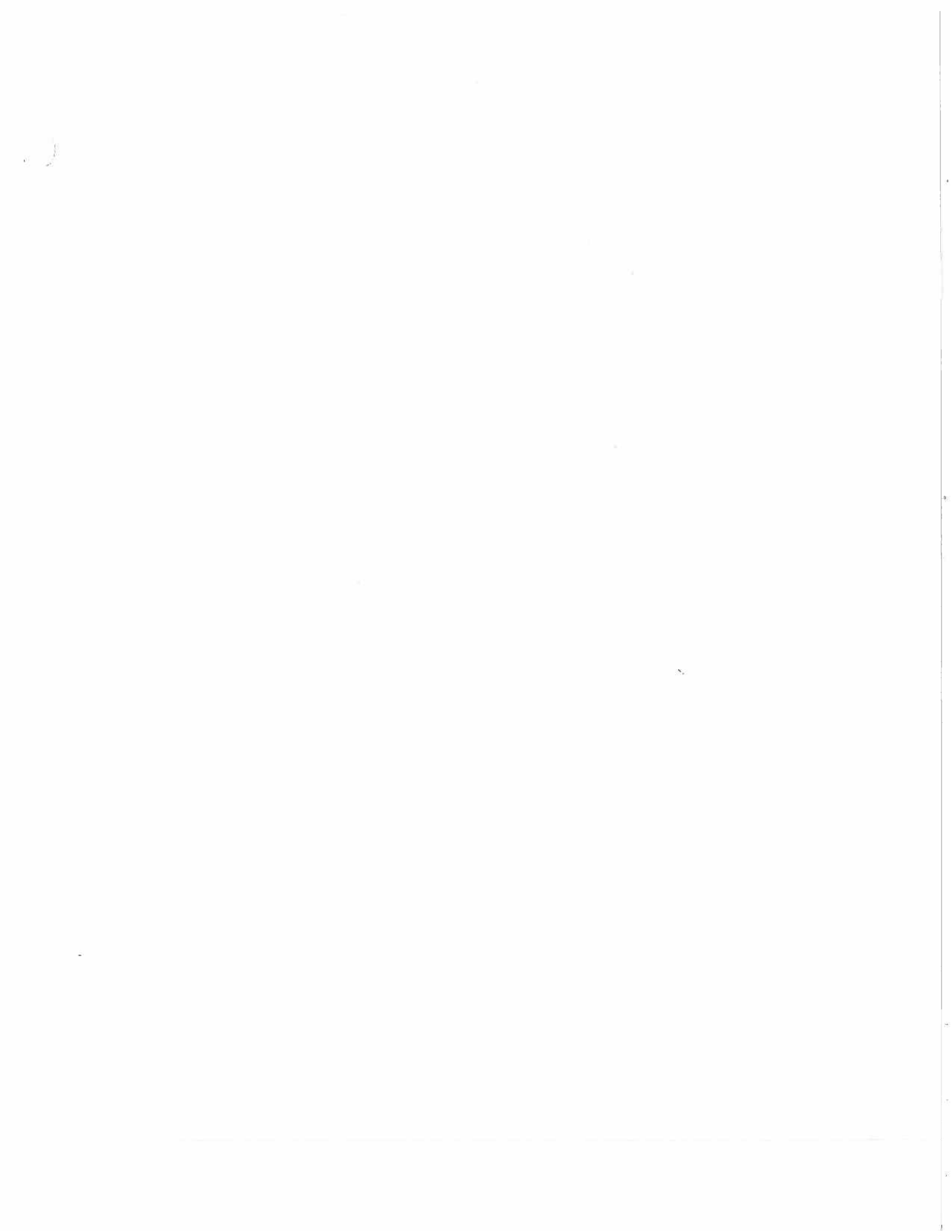
